This Month: Diving Lake George

Larry Dufour will be speaking to us this month about diving in Lake George.

Lake George is a 32 mile long spring fed lake just west of Vermont in the state of New York. The clear water makes for good diving as well as a few

wrecks at the bottom. The area was strategic during the French and Indian war and the American Revolution with Fort Ticonderoga to the north and Fort William Henry to the south.

Larry will discuss the rules of diving the lake

as well as the most popular dive sites. We will also look at the many other activities that the lake offers as there are many tourist attractions in the area as well as hiking and fishing.

WHERE: Ken and Joan Kadaras' house

WHAT: Go diving in the lake and carve your pumpkin under water or enjoy what the divers create



We'll fire up the grill and have burgers and dogs
Got a favorite desert or salad - bring it!
(this is a rain or shine event)

Bring your hollowed out pumpkin (seeds removed)
Divers should bring extra weights to sink the pumpkin
Bring your carving tools
Dive in the lake and carve your pumpkin under the water

Directions: 18 Robinwood Rd., Littleton, MA 01460 978-486-8170
From Rte. 495 take the Rte. 119 exit (exit 31) west toward Groton.
About 1 mile, take a right on Beaver Brook Rd. (Left if driving from Groton on Rte. 119).
Follow Beaver Brook Rd. for about a mile and take a left on Green Needles Rd.
Follow Green Needles Rd., for about ¼ mile and take a left on Deer Run Rd.
Follow Deer Run for about 200 yards and take a right on Robinwood Rd.
Follow Robinwood Rd. for about 100 yards and take the right fork.
House is the first one on the right - beige. (you can see it at the fork) Pull in driveway.
