

## Who are we and what are we about?

**United Divers** is a dive club with a membership focused on scuba diving. The club believes in promoting the sport of scuba diving in a safe, responsible manner. This is achieved by actual dive experience, knowledge gained through the club meetings and club sponsored activities.

As a new diver or new club member you will enjoy the shore and boat dives the club sponsors. These dives are organized by an experienced diver who is interested in helping the new diver learn the ropes and gain additional diving experience.

For the intermediate skill level diver, you will enjoy sharing your experience and knowledge with new divers while gaining additional insight from the experienced divers.

Experienced divers will enjoy the boat and shore dives specifically geared toward them. Wreck dives, deeper dives, night dives, and cave dives are great ways to keep the more experienced diver challenged and interested in diving.

All in all, the club strives to offer something for divers of all skill levels.

**United Divers** has monthly club meetings from February to November. At these meetings, club members gather to listen and share their dive experiences. Members of our club share interests that range from underwater collecting, wreck diving, deep diving, mixed gas diving, underwater photography and video, and much more. Each club meeting also offers a special segment that is meant to entertain and educate the membership. Guest speakers cover a wide variety of diving activities and share their interesting stories.

In addition to the monthly club meetings, the club publishes a monthly newsletter which is e-mailed to the membership throughout the year. **United Divers** also maintains a website, **www.UnitedDivers.org** that always has the most up-to-date information for club members to refer to. The monthly club meetings, as well as the newsletter and website are organized, maintained and run by the six member Board of Directors. The membership of the club elect the Board of Directors annually. The members currently filling the positions for this year can be found on the website. The Board of Director positions are: President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer, Membership Coordinator, and Activities Director.

## Becoming a Member

Anybody may join the club! Certified or not, as long as you have an interest in scuba diving, you will enjoy participating with our club. To join, you may attend a meeting and request an application, or you may visit our website at **www.UnitedDivers.org** and download the application to bring to a meeting. All members must complete the membership application as well as the waiver of liability forms. Family memberships will also require the family form, listing all the members of the family, and a waiver of liability for each family member.

As a member applicant, your membership application is read at our monthly meeting to the members in attendance and then voted on for acceptance.

Dues are \$25.00 annually for a single member. Dues for an entire family are just \$40.00 per year. A non-certified individual may join the club as an associate member for \$25.00 per year. Associate members have all the privileges of regular members, but are not eligible to vote or hold office.

Your dues support the financial requirements of the club such as: the monthly newsletter, our website, meeting hall, and guest speakers.
